

COUNTY OF CLARK.) AFFIDAVIT OF TOM COLLINS

TOM COLLINS, first being duly sworn, declares and says:

1. I am over the age of eighteen (18), of sound mind, and competent to testify to the within facts of which I have personal knowledge.
2. I am a duly elected Commissioner in Clark County, and a member of the Board of County Commissioners for Clark County, State of Nevada.
3. I was present at the February 19, 2013 and March 5, 2013 meetings of the Board of County Commissioners meeting when the agenda item and ordinance were introduced that the Board "having made a finding" proposed to amend Title 2 of the Clark County Code by adding a new chapter 2.14 and Ordinance 2.14.10 abolishing the Office of the Constable for the Las Vegas Township, effective January 4, 2015.
4. I was present at the March 19, 2013 Board of County Commissioners meeting when the agenda item was set for public hearing and voted on by the Board of County Commissioners.
5. The agenda item was never based on any objective "finding" other than the predetermined effort by the Board to keep John Bonaventura off the ballot and from running for re-election.
6. There was never any true factual finding as required by the statute that the Office of the Las Vegas Township Constable was unnecessary. In fact, the office is very necessary and serves a vital role in Las Vegas Township and Clark County.
7. The plan was that after the election and a period of time had passed, the ordinance would be rescinded and the Office reinstated.
8. This idea and plan was reviewed by and received the support of the Clark County District Attorney Civil Division, which also reviewed and drafted the proposed ordinance before introduction on February 19, 2013.
